To the Parents/Guardians of incoming sixth grade students:

Indiana State Department of Health and Department of Education immunization requirements for students entering 6th grade for the Fall of 2019 are: Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Acellular Pertussis (Tdap) and Meningococcal (Menactra) vaccines. The details of the new requirements for 6th graders are listed below and can be found at CHIRP.in.gov

*Tdap- every child born on or after Jan. 1, 1997 and entering Grade 6 shall have received one dose of Tdap

*Meningococcal vaccine- Every child born on or after January 1, 1997 and entering Grade 6 shall have received one dose of Meningococcal vaccine.

Summer break is a great time to get the required shots, and annual physicals for the upcoming school year. Please make arrangements for your student(s) with their Healthcare Provider.

Your child may have already received these new immunizations. Please submit records to the main office of your child's current school. If you have questions about these vaccines, please contact your health care provider. If you do not have a healthcare provider, you can contact your Local Health Department for free or reduced cost immunizations.

Please be aware that if these requirements are not met your child may be excluded from school.
