

Dear Career and Success Academy Families,

Since the start of this pandemic, it has been our goal to have all of our students with us for in person learning. We believe that students learn best when they are in our schools and learning from our highly qualified teachers. This has been a challenging time for everyone but the efforts and precautions we have all made have helped to lower the community spread of COVID-19.

The Indiana State Department of Health advisory level for St. Joseph County has now been yellow for two weeks in a row. Counties in the yellow represent moderate community spread indicating schools can operate all grade levels in person.

Today, we are excited to announce that **Career Academy Middle School and High School students will begin a phased transition back to in-person learning four days a week.**

Wednesday, March 3rd - Middle School students return to in person instruction

Monday, March 8th – High School students return to in person instruction

Details:

- At this time, only students currently attending hybrid instruction are eligible to attend in person all four days.
- Students in grades 6-12 will attend four days a week, with Fridays being 100% virtual for all students.
- Students in grades 6-12 who are currently 100% virtual will continue with virtual learning.
- School start and end times will remain the same.
- There is no change in plans for Success Academy students.

We appreciate all your support through these challenging times. Please continue to practice social distancing, wearing masks, keeping your students at home if they have symptoms and avoiding large gatherings to provide a safe environment for all our students.
